Please bring your child to the first day of camp on Monday, July 11 shortly before 9:00 am. We will meet at the picnic area at Lutheran Central. Please stay with your camper until our camp director addresses the group. There will be a short explanation about the traffic pattern, pick-up times (12:00), places, etc. After the first day, you may drop your children at the picnic area. We will be there to greet them.

In the event your plans change, please notify us immediately. It is expected that other children will be on a waiting list and that we may be able to replace your child if enough notice is given. We cannot guarantee a refund if time does not allow us to replace your child with a standby.

Classes will be held inside at Lutheran Central. The campers should dress comfortably with the possibility of getting messy. **Please do not wear clothes that would be inappropriate for getting "art" on them!** They will be working with paints, dyes, clay, etc. Campers should not bring anything with them. All of the art materials will be included.

SNACKS – A snack will be provided for your camper. If your camper has special needs for a snack, please provide the snack. Also, campers are not required to eat the snack. For example, if you don't like vanilla pudding – don't take it and immediately throw it away – simply don't take it.

Almost the last point:

BFA reserves the right to adjust the time of the camp to *MAYBE* dismiss at 11:30 instead of 12:00 if enrollment numbers are unexpectedly small. How could enrollment numbers be small at \$20? We will give you plenty of warning via email and at the first day meeting if this change is necessary. We hope to have 30 children.

And the most important point:

"Mom! Look at what I did!" "Dad! My art teacher said I was pretty good at this." Sharing enthusiasm is a very important part of the camp experience. Ask your camper, "What did you do today? Can I see it?"

Students will be bringing items home each day. *Brag on them!* Pottery projects will be fired on Thursday and hopefully ready to take home on the last day of camp. If not, you will be instructed when to come back with your child to pick up this project. It is important to your camper!
